ORDER


Pursuant to Local Rule 1.09(a), Plaintiff Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC") moved this Court for an Order temporarily sealing this new civil action on April 15, 2019. The CFTC asked that its new civil action be sealed until the earlier of: (1) seventy-two (72) hours following issuance of the requested ex parte statutory restraining order ("SRO"); or (2) when counsel for the CFTC informed the Clerk of Court that the seal is no longer necessary. For good cause shown, this Court granted the CFTC's motion to temporarily seal the matter (Doc. # 5) and entered the SRO at 2:30 p.m. on April 15, 2019. (Doc. # 7).
