**ORDER**

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on the **Government's Motion Pursuant to USSG §3E1.1(b). (Dkt. 48)** The United States requests that the Court to grant a one-level reduction in the Defendant's total offense level because the Defendant entered a timely guilty plea. The timely plea permitted the government to avoid trial preparation and permitted the Court and the government to allocate resources efficiently.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. The **Government's Motion Pursuant to USSG §3E1.1(b)** is hereby **GRANTED**.
2. The Defendant's total offense level is reduced by one level. This reduction is already reflected in the U.S. Probation Officer's Presentence Investigation Report.
