## <u>ORDER</u>

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on the **Government's Unopposed Motion to Further Postpone BOP Report Date. (Dkt. 65)** The Defendant is currently set to report to the BOP no earlier than December 2021. The government is requesting a further postponement of the Defendant's report date until the conclusion of his coconspirator's trial, which is set on the February 2022 calendar. In addition, the Government requests that the Defendant's conditions of release be modified to allow him to leave his home to meet with government counsel for trial preparation purposes. Counsel for the Defendant and Pretrial Services have no objection to the Government's requests.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

- The Government's Unopposed Motion to Further Postpone BOP Report Date is hereby GRANTED.
- The Defendant shall report to his designated institution as determined by the Bureau of Prisons no earlier than March 2022.

 The Defendant's term of supervision is hereby modified to allow him to leave his home to meet with government counsel for trial preparation purposes only.
