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ORDER

This cause comes before the Court for consideration of the Receiver’s Eighteenth Interim Motion for Order Awarding Fees, Costs and Reimbursement of Costs to Receiver and His Professionals (Doc. 776) and his Supplement to the Motion (Doc. 777). Plaintiff Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“CFTC”) does not oppose the granting of the

relief sought and neither do Defendants Anile, Da Corta, Montie, Haas, and Duran (Doc. 776 at 22; Doc. 777). The Receiver did not consult the United States (as an intervening party) because the government has not previously taken a position on the Receiver's fee applications, and the stay the government obtained expired on July 24, 2022 (Doc. 776 at 22).

Upon due consideration, the Receiver's Eighteenth Interim Motion for Order Awarding Fees, Costs and Reimbursement of Costs to Receiver and His Professionals (Doc. 776) is **GRANTED**. The Court awards the following sums and directs that payment be made from the Receivership assets:
