**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSE IN
OPPOSITION TO RECEIVER MOTION FOR ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

STEPHEN N. PREZIOSI, appellate attorney for Mr. Michael DaCorta, pursuant to Local Rule 3.01 (d), respectfully requests that this Honorable Court permit me an extension of time of two weeks (until May 1, 2026) to file a Response in opposition to the receiver's motion for an order to show cause. (Doc. 904). My answer is currently due on April 17, 2026. I have communicated with the Receiver Burton Wiand's Office, and he has consented to the extension of time of two weeks.

Summary

Mr. Preziosi requests an extension of time of two weeks (until May 1, 2026) to file a response to the Receiver Burton Wiand's motion for an order to show cause and seeking contempt findings. (Doc. 904). I communicated with Mr. Wiand's office, and he has consented to this request for an extension of two weeks.

The reason for the request for the extension is the heavy case-load in my office, which included this month oral argument before the Appellate Division, First Department of New York in the case of People v. Urgitano (April 14); a reply brief due in the Appellate Division, Second Department New York in the case of People v. Frias (April 16); a writ of Habeas Corpus in the Appellate Division, Second Department New York in the case of People v. Rosen (April 20). As all of these cases are very intensive criminal cases, requiring extensive amounts of my time and efforts regarding clients that are in custody after felony convictions where the deadlines had

been set prior to my receiving Mr. Wiand's motion, I request that this Court grant my request for an extension of time to respond in this case.

Memorandum of Law


This Court has the authority to grant leave for an extension of time to answer under Local Rule 3.01. I am not seeking an extension for the purpose of delay, but only because I had previous deadlines on appeals as set out above which had been set by the Appellate Courts prior to receiving Mr. Wiand's motion.

WHEREFORE, I respectfully request that this Court grant this Motion for an extension of time of two weeks, until May 1, 2026 to answer the motion.
